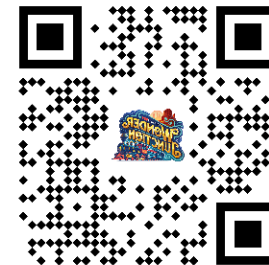
**Vacation Bible School Meeting** Sunday May 25th VBS Meeting for those that are helping. This will be in the gym after the Contemporary Service.
